


### Our Philosophy

### Our Purpose

Our Hampton Roads Police Athletic League (HRPAL) Afterschool Program; is designed for youth, in grades 3 to 8 within identified Hampton City Schools (HCS) and we operate according to the HCS academic calendar. Elementary students will begin at 2:15 pm and middle school students will begin at 4 pm each day; programming will end each day at 6pm. A snack and dinner will be provided for the students each day. Transportation is also provided to and from our location for students based upon need.

### Our goals are to:

- 1. Provide quality afterschool enrichment activities that promote positive academic achievement and prosocial development.
- 2. To provide students a structured and safe environment that promotes a positive attitude toward law enforcement officers.
